They have their messaging app notifications set to default notification sound, a specific system of the system or a custom audio user receives a brand new Android phone and / or updates on Android 10+ The Android configuration process tries to transfer the old setting , but the older the previous setting is not an option on the new phone. This could be due to the fact that the ringer file has not been transferred, the previous user used a system level notification sound that was deprecated in Android 10 or in some other reason. Rather than the default value to a specific notification sound, the system is predefined with null / none. If I could talk to a Google engineer, I point out that this seems to you a UX process that could be improved. I support that most users probably requires some sound set as default, even if they can't keep their old environment.
