It has actors you'd like to recognize, like the Oscar nominations Greg Kinnear and Thomas Hadapen Church. The welcome Margo Martindale also plays a key supporting role. Outside of a slight gore, it has nothing to shake or offend children or sensitive spectators. But the "Paradise is real" also has an agenda, which he handled easily in his declarative phrase of a title. It is the latest, and therefore much better, of the current flood of faith-based films. Hollywood is finally warming up to a market Tyler Perry has maintained for a decade. Contrary to popular belief, Perry's films are frequented by Churchgoers of all skin colors. The Polish church on my block sends me letters (I guess Jesus gave them my address) inviting me to group the screenings of Madea's latest film and "Son of God." Based on a bestselling book by Todd Burpo and Lynn Vincent, "Heaven Is for Real" tells the story of how Burpo's 4-year-old son Colton (Connor Corum) visited heaven and lived to tell his pleasures. Colton didn't really go; he was just under some nice anesthesia during an appendectomy. Colton returns home armed with knowledge he'd never been deprived of before. He knows things about his family that no one told him. When pressed by Todd (Greg Kinnear), Colton insists that Jesus informed him about these matters. I have no problem believing the plot line of this movie; If I can believe that Captain America is darting across the sky with the "she hates me" star, I can believe that a little boy went to heaven and met the Lord. In fact, as someone who died twice and doesn't get 1/1000 as a good out of body experience this fuck, I was intrigued by "Paradise is real." But, without failing, every time I found myself liking this movie, it would break the spell with its further motives. To make his points, he relies on the kind of economic and reassuring notes of one of those psychics who pretend to talk to dead people. All the Burpos took care of is in and they are all young, except in the case of a particular character not yet born that gets much older. That character pushes " paradise is for the real" to the depths of manipulation from which he never recovers. Alike the recent "God is not dead," which is the "wiss" of faith-based films as it embodies every single claim against its kind, "paradise is real" attempts to launch apublic network. Sometimes, you can hear the director and co-writer Randall Wallace ("Braveheart") reaching beyond the low impact of his Christian audience. Dedicate credible moments of doubt to the movie's characters, asking some of the same questions a non-believer in the audience might. There is a nice don-and-take between Church Pastor Todd and his wife Sonja (Kelly Reilly) as to whether Colton's story is really the miracle it seems to be. Kinnear is very good at being consumed by his son's story and what it means spiritually. Reilly matches him, and has a nice scene in which she demands that her husband focus on life instead of the afterlife. In scenes like this, the characters feel real and identifiable. The problem is that "Heaven is for Real" can't leave enough alone. You have to show your hand at all times. It destroys the beautiful mystery of Coltonâs experience and uses improper methods to shame the unconverted. I'm fine with preaching the choir, like I used to be in that choir. But winning laps, sticking the tongue out at non-members and hi-fiving the choir while singing "Amirite," doesn't help the cause. For example: In distress, Todd visits a therapist who is not a Christian. Their conversation begins interestingly, with Todd citing that perhaps his non-belief will help him put things into perspective. When he offers a scientific explanation that the brain induces hallucinogenic chemicals when a person is close to death, Todd gives him a kiss-off line on not having faith. Later, we see this same shrink at Todd's church. Why's he there? An accusatory line turned you into Shirley Caesar? Another example: Colton tells us about his Heaven, and is quite vivid from his words. But Wallace must also show it to us, which can only lead to disappointment because she is incredibly skilled and stereotyped. There are angels (who don't dance on the head of a pin because this is Protestant paradise), a population that proves that I never had a chance to get past the pearly doors, and of course, Jesus out of the camera. He has an aura of mystery and a soothing voice, but he never confronts us; we can project our expectations on appearance. Unfortunately, "Heaven is for Real" only HAS to show us the face of Jesus and, unlike the hippy in those paintings that your grandmother had on her wall (or in my grandmother had on her wall (or in my grandmother). Jesus bears a messy resemblance to Kenny Logg Ins. "That's it", I said to myself. Fortunately, the movie was over. Kinnear makes a good preacher and a good comic book. I liked it, and I loved his last sermon where he reflects on how people measure with sticks when they should be looking for them in much smaller sizes. veteran Dean Semler's widescreen cinematography is gorgeous to watch(it is mostly outside, so the artistic direction is of God) and Wallace directs the moments tightened and quiet with such a grace that irritated me when he continued to scream and wide. I really wanted to like this movie, but he kept hitting me in the eye every time I went close. My two stars, halfway, seem appropriate to a preacher son who left the flock 20 years ago, destined to never return. Add two stars to my rating if you are a true believer who goes to church every Sunday. Now you take half a star, because you know that God will strike you for lying about going every Sunday.
